

# WEEKEND GREENHOUSE WATERER

This is a great job for someone who likes to work independently and be around plants!

# Responsibilities:

- Opening the greenhouses, high tunnels and cold frames.
- Thoroughly watering plants in the greenhouses and on the cold frames.
- Possibility of combining this position with a store or part-time field position, depending on prior experience.

# Qualifications:

- Attention to detail.
- Responsible, efficient and self-motivated.
- Able to comfortably lift 30 lbs and walk over uneven ground.
- Reliable transportation to the farm.
- Prior experience with gardening or working in a greenhouse is a plus, but not required.
- This job will require the ability to communicate in a timely manner with one of the farmers on the weekend about the state of the greenhouse and any schedule adjustments based on weather (usually once or twice per weekend)

### Schedule:

- March mid-August
- Morning opening and watering usually takes 1 2 hours.
- Regular Saturday and Sunday availability is a must. Optional additional watering hours during the week are also available.
- Start time is dependent on the weather. On sunny days, ability to start by 8am is crucial in order to ventilate the cold frames and high tunnels. Cooler and cloudier days allow for a more flexible start time around 10am.

### Compensation:

Pay is \$15/hour, plus a CSA membership (about \$50+ worth of vegetables per week)
